- 1. Sales associate- friendly, engaging and ideally interested in product, merchandising and styling, jewelry design and/or fine art. Will be selling to and creating quotes for the general public as well as design professionals. Articulate, a sense of humor and sales experience are a plus. No drugs or smoking on premises.
- 2. Follow-up with clients via email. Communicate with 25+ local makers/crafts persons to help generate estimates for custom pieces. Knowledge of architecture, interior design, fine art, woodworking or jewelry design helpful, but not required.
- 3. Assist with daily opening and closing procedures. Including light book- keeping, maintenance of gallery.
