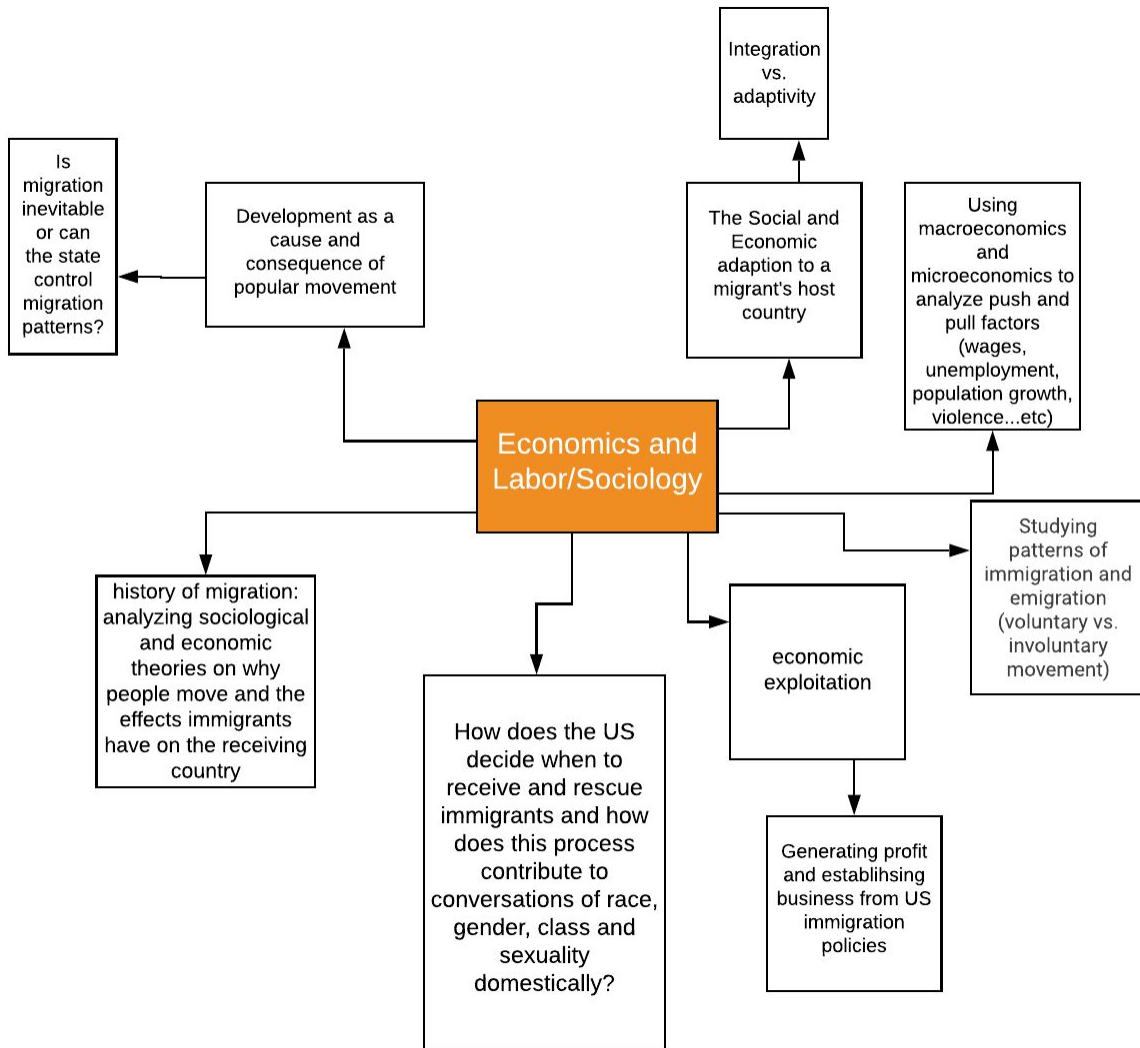


The Goal is to eventually create a website that will show these graphs and each box will direct the visitor to the syllabus (as well as reading material) that addresses such topic when clicked upon.

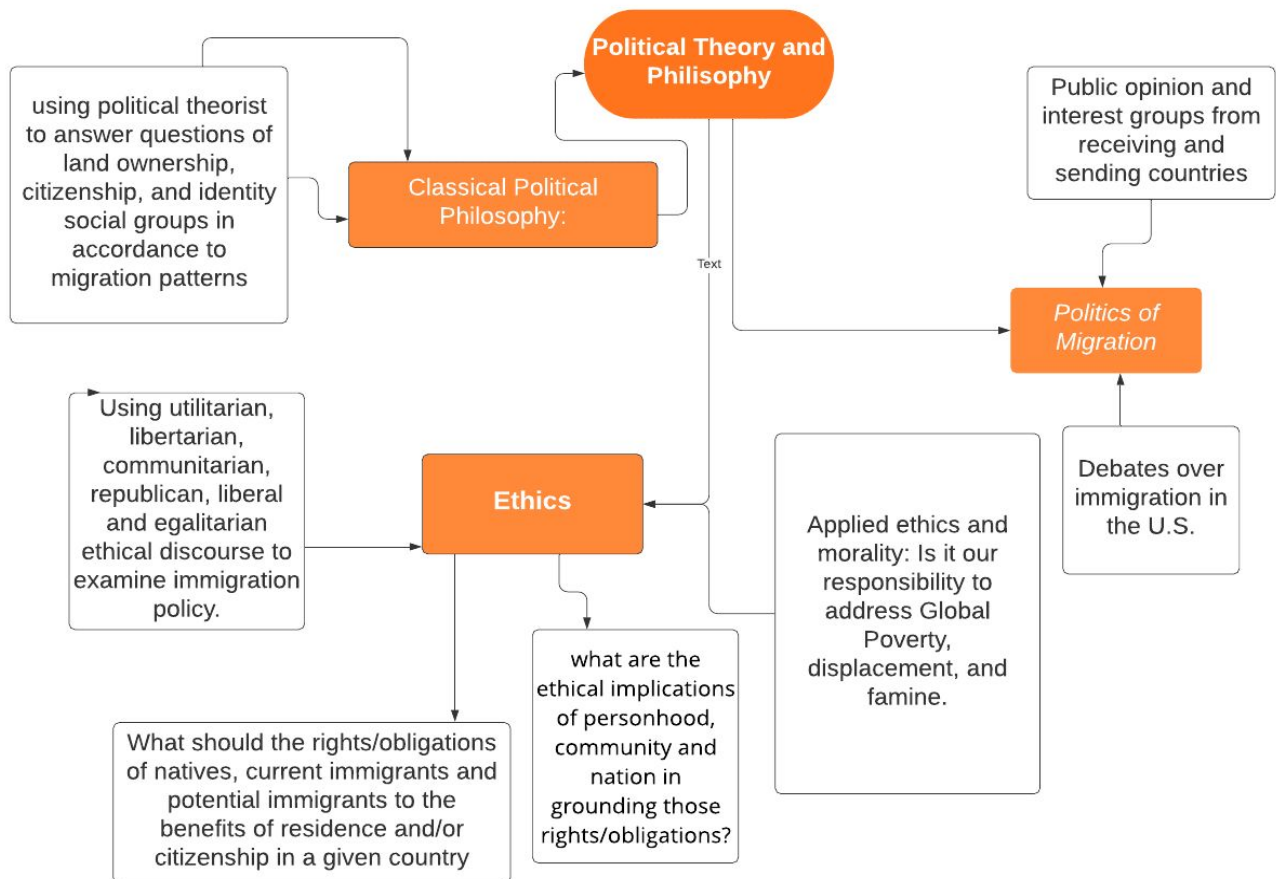

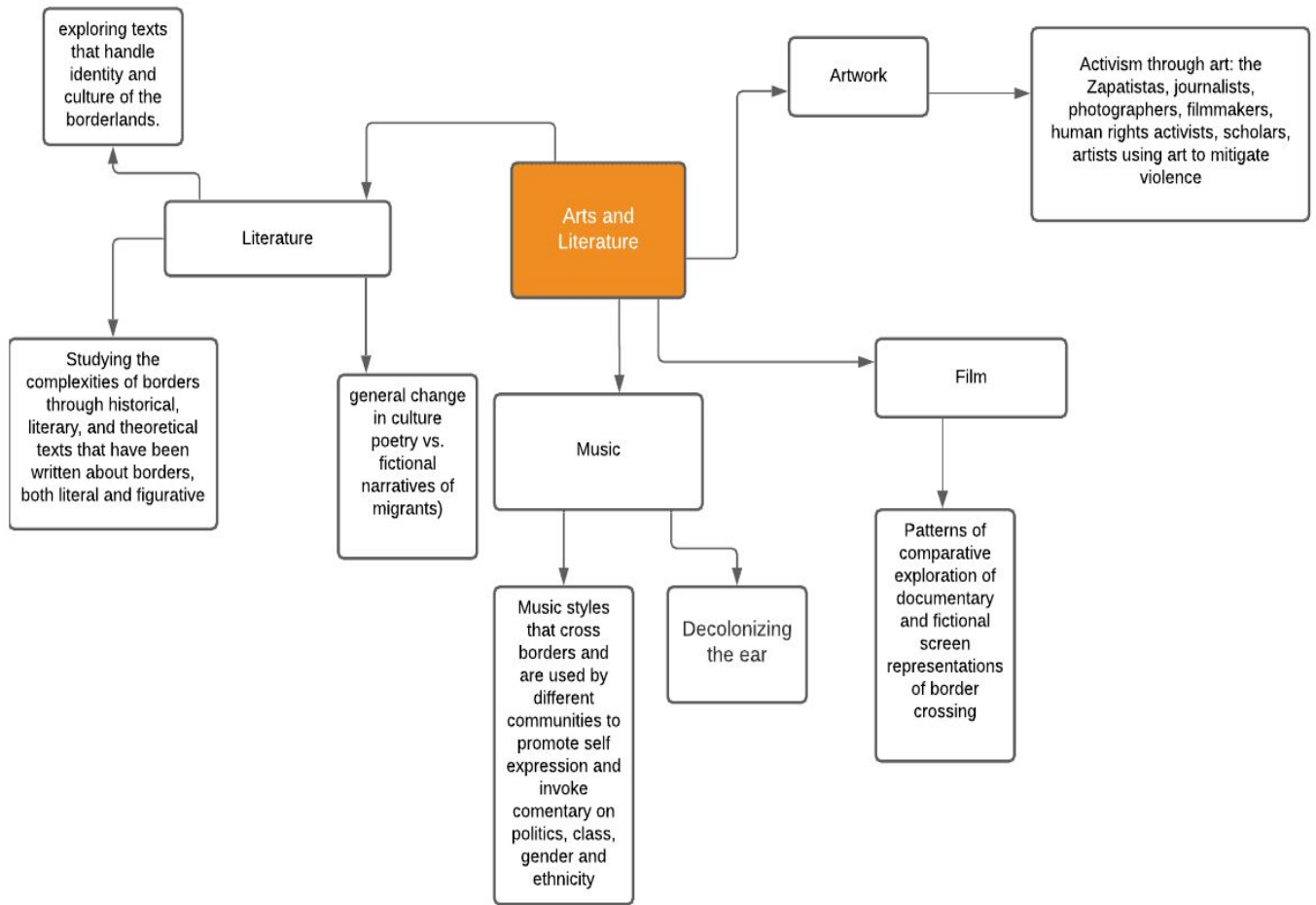

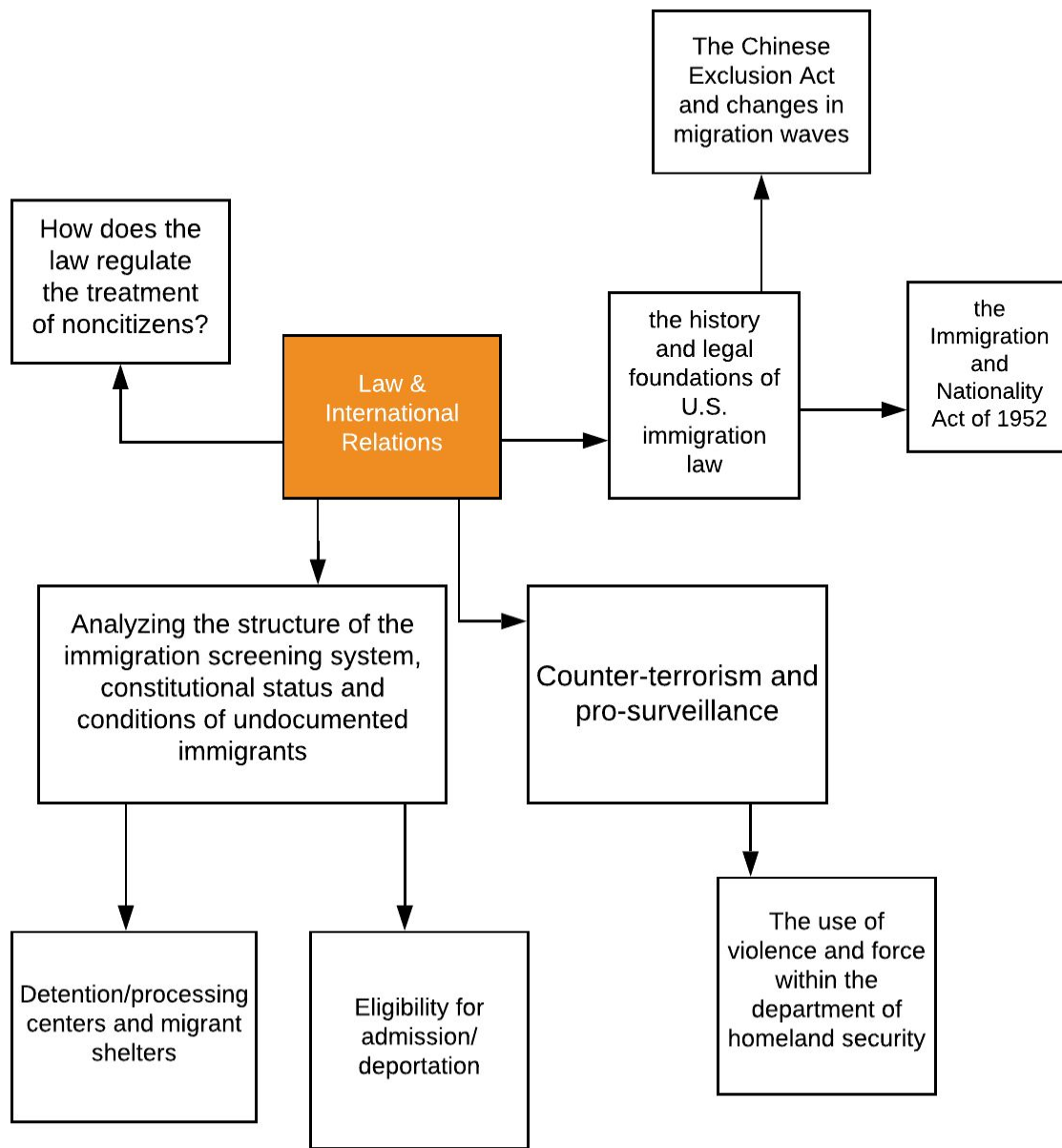
